The name "Bloody Mary" is associated with Queen Mary of England, nicknamed as such in Foxe's Book of Martyrs for attempting to re-establish the Catholic Church. In the US, it's usually consumed in the morning, as a hangover cure.

Mimosa* 139

The mimosa is believed to have been invented at the Hôtel Ritz Paris by Frank Meier, in about 1925. The original recipe for the Mimosa calls for a teaspoon or so of Grand Marnier. This variant is called the "Grand Mimosa" today.
