This fanning-grade green tea is manufactured using the Sencha technique where, after withering, the green leaf is exposed to steam, allowing it to deenzyme and retain a delicate flavour. Brilliantly light, straw-yellow liquor, cleansing with a slightly toasty note and drying finish.
